REPORTS

SHERIFF – The Trustees reviewed the Sheriff Report for March 2014.

ZONING – Mr. Gottschalk was at the FDIC Conference.

FIRE – Mr. Woodruff was at the FDIC Conference. Mr. Brinker reported that Randy & Skip visited Home Depot last Wednesday. Home Depot will fly Randy to Atlanta, GA to get a look at the sprinkler system at their location. The site was named the Troy Distribution Center. This location will be 70% retail sales and 30% internet sales whereas sites from here to the east are 70% internet sales and 30% retail sales. Mr. Levorchick reported that Sandy Minarik talked to members of the communities where Home Depot has distribution centers and all said they like Home Depot.


