#### OLD BUSINESS

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS – Mr. Brinker opened the Open Road Improvement Bids for 2021. The Wood County Engineer's office provided the Bid Form for Strail Road between Stony Ridge Road and Luckey Road, Recker Road between Bradner Road and Fostoria Road, Dowling Road between Tracy Road and Stony Ridge Road and Devils Hole Road between Lemoyne Road and Pemberville Road which totaled \$404,100.00.

Road bids which include the total of all four roads are as follows:

- Bower Asphalt & Paving \$401,697.00
- Henry W. Bergman, Inc. \$386,388.00
- Shelly Company \$398,356.00
- Morelock Asphalt, LTD \$471,879.00
- Gerken Paving \$355,530.95

After review Mr. Recker made a motion to accept the lowest and best bid of \$355,530.95 from Gerken Paving subject their good standing with the state with a second by Mr. Greulich with roll call: Mr. Greulich-yes, Mr. Recker-yes and Mr. Brinker-yes. Motion passed.

CORONAVIRUSE RELIEF FUND – The Trustees discussed how to use the Balance of 3,080.03 plus interest. They discussed dividing the funds among food banks in Troy Township. More information will be gathers concerning Food Banks in Troy Township. Mr. Greulich and Mrs. Hahn will gather information.


The next regular meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 30, 2021 at 7:30 pm.
